Waikanae Church Report

Our main focus over the last few weeks has been preparing the house at Robert Grove for our new minister, Anna. Special thanks go to Don and Marie Smith, Desmond Corrigan, and Evan Ireland, who have worked tirelessly on the premises inside and out for many weeks. The results are outstanding.

On 8 May, our congregation received a shock when we were told that Ian and Sharon Marsden were relocating to Christchurch as soon as possible. Ian and Sharon have contributed heavily to the church and the parish in a multitude of ways. Ian has single-handedly maintained the church building for several years, until recently when Jesus sent a cohort in Desmond Corrigan. Sharon has given of her time and expertise in selling items online for the parish, and has contributed thousands of dollars in sales to the parish coffers. The Marsdens have also taken services individually and together for several years, hosted a home group, and been congenial and welcoming members of our church during that time. We will miss their service, dedication, humour, and friendship.

Waveney Bowman is also leaving the Kapiti Coast to go back home to New York towards the end of May. We will especially miss her brilliant singing, and her cheerful disposition. We expect to see her back in September to celebrate her mother Monica Olsson's 100th birthday.

Following Ian's resignation from Waicom, the preaching roster, and the Parish Council, the Waikanae committee met on 8 May and voted Renata Joyner to be the new convener. Ian's other tasks and duties were also redistributed.

The church's neighbour is doing groundwork and has removed the large hedge between the two properties in preparation for building a new fence. This will free up about 2m of our backyard, which will be great for the playgroup children. The west side is now very open and bright. The neighbour has also donated some concrete blocks to us, which we will use to build a small retaining wall at the back of the property.

Desmond and Ian have continued doing maintenance tasks around the church, including painting, repairs, and gardening.

In April, we had a one-month trial of opening the church to members of the congregation on a Tuesday afternoon between 1pm and 3pm. People
