Anne Solomon performs Bach’s Partita in D minor for Solo Violin, BWV 1004: Kapiti Uniting Parish, Waikanae Church, Thursday 15 September at 6 pm.

Bach’s D minor partita is one of the most famous pieces of the solo violin repertoire. It contains five movements, each with a distinctive character. The first four are short, the jewel being the final one: the Chaconne, a Baroque fantasy of extraordinary intricacy and depth. Revered by violinists through the centuries, it also been transcribed by the great composers for a variety of other instruments.

Anne is a London violinist who retrained in medicine after a career in classical music. She moved to the Kapiti Coast with her family in 2020 and this is her first recital since arriving. Programme length: approximately 25 minutes. Admission - koha (suggested koha \$5 - \$10.) Children free. All proceeds go to Kapiti Uniting Parish.
