Parish Anniversary 10 June 1984

Three Presbyterian congregations and a Methodist congregation in Paraparaumu/Raumati and the Waikanae Methodist congregation joined to form the Kapiti Co-operating Parish.

The name changed later to Kapiti Uniting Parish.

Several buildings were sold. The congregation met in the old hall.

In 1989 the current church at Raumati was built.
